West Vancouver Memorial Library is pleased to announce a new ongoing volunteer opportunity for secondary students in grades 10 – 12: Teen Technology Mentors (TTMs).

The Library offers digital learning programs for people of all ages in The Lab: West Vancouver's Digital Learning Place. TTMs will help participants with troubleshooting, reinforce instructions and provide encouragement. Programs are led by Library staff and training for volunteers is provided. Program participants are mainly adults and youth aged 4 – 13.

This program is aimed at those who are comfortable working with technology and enjoy working with adults (especially older adults) and children.

Benefits to teens

- Earn regular weekly volunteer hours in an area of interest
- Gain experience and skills with various technologies
- Receive training from librarians
- Get involved in the community
- Resumé-building

Requirements

To become a TTM, teens must:

- Be available for two hours per week, after school and/or on weekends
- Complete the West Vancouver Community Centre's Youth Volunteer Orientation
- Have a valid BC Services Card
- Be in grades 10 – 12
- Commit to volunteering for a minimum four-month term
