Write or draw a story or comic

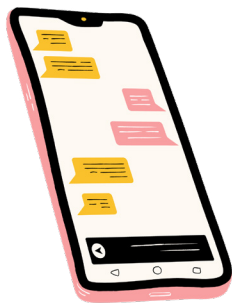
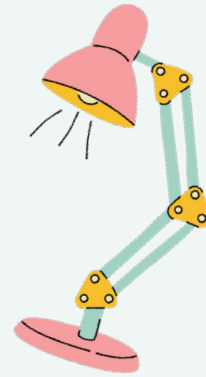
Write to a **local councillor** about something that's important to you in your community. What do you value about your community? What do you wish would change?
