If an item is unavailable, you can place a hold to be notified when it comes in—just log into your online account or ask us.

Renewing

If your item is approaching its due date and it has no holds on it, we'll automatically renew it for you and send you a notice with the new due date.

Returning

Our book drops are open 24/7.

Fees

WVML doesn't charge daily late fees on materials. We do still charge late fees for items borrowed from other libraries through Interlibrary Loan, for holds not picked up, and for lost or damaged items.

When you sign up for a WVML card, you're responsible for all materials borrowed on your card and for any charges on items that are lost, damaged, or not returned to us.
