

Digitizing **8mm and Hi8 Tapes** using Sony Hi8 Handycam and Elgato Video Capture

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I. Equipment


This digitization project requires the following equipment (borrow at CCC desk):

- SONY CCD-TRV118 Hi8 Handycam (includes 3.5 mm AV to RCA AV cable and power cord)
- Elgato Video Capture device



II. Getting Started


Log in to the Digitization on Demand computer. You can log in with your library card or a guest pass.



Plug the other end of the RCA cables into the Elgato Video Capture device.

Plug the USB end of the Elgato Video Capture device **directly** into the computer.

Please do not use a USB hub. Elgato requires a direct connection.





Open the power cover on the bottom back of the camera. Plug in the Camcorder power cord at both ends.

The DC (notched rectangle) end goes into the **DC-IN** terminal on the camera.



Turn the handycam **On** by pressing down on the green button on the **power dial** and rotating it down so that the white line points to **PLAYER.**





To insert your 8mm/Hi8 tape into the camcorder, use the **OPEN/EJECT** switch on the bottom of the camcorder.



Slide the tab toward the front of the camera.

The cassette compartment cover will open and the tape holder will automatically extend.



Insert your 8mm or Hi8 tape.

Press the **PUSH** mark on the cassette compartment.

Wait while your tape fully retracts before closing the compartment cover.



III. Setting Up Elgato Video Capture


III.I. Get Started

Open the Elgato Video Capture application on the computer. The application will guide you through the video digitization process. Follow the prompts on the screen. 📑 Elgato Video Capture X video capture Λ Record video from a VCR, DVR, set-top box, camcorder or any other analog video source to watch and share on your PC. Play your captured video in Windows Media Player or add it to iTunes to sync with an iPod, iPhone or Apple TV. 

Before continuing, check that:

- Your headphones are plugged in to the computer
- The computer system sound is on and the volume is at an audible level
 - To check, click the volume symbol ^(j) on the bottom right of the Task Bar





IV. Record

Elgato Video Capture video capture Get Started Connect Video Connect Audio Record	If you would like Elgato to stop recording after your estimated video length, check the box next to Automatically stop recording after X minutes.

LIGHT BATT INFO REW - PLAY - FF FF FF PAUSE	Rewind ⁴⁴ your tape to the beginning by using the button on the top of the handycam. Hit PauseII once you have rewound the tape to the begininning (or wherever you would like to start your recording).



Automatically stop recording after 60 minutes Mute sound Go Back Start Recording	Click the red Start Recording button in the Elgato application.	
LIGHT BATTINFO REWE -PLAY- STOP PAUSE	Press Play on the camcorder. Your video will start recording.	
You will need to wait for the duration of your video while it is recorded.		


Once you would like to stop the recording, you can click the red **Stop Recording** button.

If you had checked the box to automatically stop the recording, it will stop on its own.



V. Trim

This is an optional step. If you do not wish to trim your recording, you may click **Continue**.





VI. Finish Up

Your movie will automatically save in the file location you chose in **Preferences**. By default, this is the **Videos** folder on the PC.
